


Social Trading

Social trading gives traders access to live trades placed by other traders within the trading community. The Social Stream (main view) contains the last 100 live trades and pending orders placed by other traders in the social trading community.

Statistics pertaining to each trader's trading history, since opening a trading account, are available to help copiers choose the right trading master for them.

Once a trader joined the social trading community his position will be available to the community, including trade instrument, direction, rate and time.



Signing up to the Community



In order to have access to the Trading community, view profiles, and automatically copy trades, you must sign up and join the Social trading community with a live account:

Click on 2 Join Now!

- Choose a nickname of your choice and select an avatar or upload your own photo (some restrictions may apply)
- 2. Accept the terms & conditions and click "Join".
- 3. A flag may appear on the top left hand corner of your Avatar representing the country where you signed up from.





Understanding the stream

The **Top Ranked Traders** window contains information about the 10 traders who according to an algorithm are worth following. The algorithm takes into consideration the number of days passed since the account was opened, annual P/L and maximum drawdown.

The **Spotlight** window presents a randomly chosen trader from the Top Traders list. The groups from which a trader will be selected are:

- 10 most copied
- Highest annual P/L
- Highest monthly P/L

When a new trader is presented in the Spotlight window, information about the groups from which he was chosen and the trader's information pertaining within that group is shown.

The window will update every 10 minutes or when clicked on "Refresh".







The trader's monthly P/L is presented in the bottom left corner and the category from which the trader was selected is presented in the bottom right.

The Social Stream window contain live trades and pending orders placed by Social Trading Community.

Each trade going through the Social Stream contains data regarding the instrument traded, direction, rate and when the trade was placed.


Closing trades also contain the profit percentage and the number of traders who copied this position.



Searching for traders

Search for a specific trader by typing his social community nickname into the search window or search for traders that match your desired trading requirements by clicking on the search icon.

Choose from the following:
Top Rated (Top Ranked)
Most Copied
Most Profitable
*** All parameters refer to a 1 yr. time period



By choosing "Advanced" you have access to the multiple search parameters:

P/L select the desired profit and loss level.

Success Rate select the desired success rate level.

Maximum Drawdown the percentage difference between the most profitable and the least profitable trades.



Viewing trader profile



Community members can view each other's profiles by clicking on a trader's avatar or nickname.

To view your own profile, click on your account name, at the top right corner of the screen.



Each Profile page will include the following:

- Nickname and avatar. The date that the trader opened their trading account will appear below their picture. Additionally, the trader may have added a short paragraph in the "About me" section.
- P/L chart shows the accumulated daily P/L per requested time period. And the daily P/L per requested time period.
- 3. The trader's 12 last trades, located in the Trader Stream.



Watch / unwatch button − Click watch in order to add this trader to your "Traders I watch" list in the Social Stream window and to be added to his watchers lists.

Copy / uncopy button – Click in order to copy this trader's trades. See 'Auto Copy' for more details.

Trader Statistics - Various statistical information about the trader


- a. **Days in the System** the number of days this trader has been trading in this trading account.
- b. Success rate % of profitable trades in the trader's portfolio within the requested time period.
- c. Average Daily P/L within the requested time period.
- d. Max Drawdown the % drop for the highest daily P/L to the lowest, within the requested time period.
- e. **Best Position** highest profit percentage received of a single trade, within the requested time period.
- f. Worst Position the worst trade entered (profit wise), within the requested time period.
- g. Risk Level calculating the total positions risk level 1 year retroactively of all positions (open and closed) in the traders account.

In order to copy another trader, select the copy button within his profile or open on the 'Copy' tab.

Enter the amount that will be allocated to copying trades from this trader

Allocate an amount of equity

- Copy fixed-size positions (available on selected platforms)
- The following window will appear:






More information about auto copying is available in the 'Auto copying' section.

The 'suggestions' section at the bottom of the screen presents traders that you may be interested in. The system will present 6 traders from the "most profitable", "most copied" traders in the social trading community.



Portfolio

The **Portfolio** tab allows access to trader's Trading Summary which is available in either a table form or as a Pie chart. The information can be requested per time period from 1 month to 1 year.




Shows the trader's trading history per instrument, providing information regarding the trading proportion within the portfolio percentage P/L as well as the number of profitable vs. losing positions.



Community

The community tab shows the selected trader's community connections:



Watchers - traders who are watching this trader.

Watching - traders who this trader is watching.

Copiers - traders who are automatically copying trades from this trader.


Copying - traders who this trader is automatically copying trades from.

Positions




The **positions** tab provides information regarding the trader's past year positions – open, pending and closed.

The information displayed include the instrument, trade direction, rates, time, P/L (if available) whether the trade was copied and whom it was copied from.





Auto Copying



The copying trader can allocate funds for copying a trader and still trade manually. In case the copying trader does not have enough funds for an automatically copied trade – the trade will NOT be copied.

- The copying trader will not be able to allocate any amount larger than his own equity.
- The trade will NOT be copied if the available rate is far from the original trade rate.
- The trade will NOT be copied if the copying trader has limiting trading condition. E.g. minimum trade size.

*** Social Stream does not show details regarding the amount traded. When copying a trade, the P/L percentage of the trade copied may vary form the original trade due to time lag and market movement between the original trade confirmation and the trade copy confirmation.

Allocate equity

You are able to allocate an amount of funds for copying trades from the master trader in proportion to the master trader's free margin.



Examples:

A trader allocates \$1,000 to a master trader who has equity of \$10,000. If the master trader opens a \$100,000 trade, a copied trade of \$10,000 will open in the copying trader's account.

A trader allocates \$1,000 to a master trader who has equity of \$100 of equity. If the master trader opens a \$1,000 trade, a copied trade of \$10,000 will open in the copying trader's account.

To calculate the copied trade size:



The amount allocated will change automatically with accrued profit/loss from previously closed copied trades.


Example:

A trader allocates \$1,000 to a master trader and has made a profit of \$200 due to a closed trade copied from the same trader. The amount allocated will automatically change to \$1,200 so now a larger amount can be allocated to copying a trade.

***Note that allocating equity does NOT limit the risk taken to the amount allocated. Information that isn't available to the copying broker, such as Master trader continuous withdrawals/deposits, may alter the copied trade amounts and may constitute risk.

Fixed size copy - available on selected platforms

A second method may be available. Choose a fixed amount to be the amount size for each trade copied. In order to select this copy type, select the following box and enter the amount you would like to allocate each time the trader you are copying opens a trade.






Once you have chosen your desired amount allocation type, select the button at the bottom of the window to begin copying. You will receive a message that you are now copying that trader. By copying a particular trader you will be automatically 'watching' this trader.

Select the 'close' button to continue.

To stop copying a trader select the button that will now appear on that trader's profile. Uncopying a trader will unlink all open copied trades from the master trader and stop copying all future positions. It is now the trader's responsibility to close copied open positions.

If you are interested in changing the copying conditions, i.e. change the amount to be allocated, type in the new amount to be allocated and click on the 'Edit Copy' button.

Select the 'close' button to continue.



The following situations can occur where the master trader places a trade, however the trade is not copied:

- a. The copier manually closed the position.
- b. The master trader had opened this position before the copier started copying him.
- c. When the master trader opened this position the copier didn't have the permission to trade the relevant instrument.
- d. The market was highly volatile and the requested rate was no longer available (including reasonable rate slippage).
- e. Copier's account trading conditions restricted the requested trade copy e.g. trade size minimum/maximum.

Market Trends



Market trends - available on selected platforms

It provides information about the popularity of the top 10 instrument and the market's view on them. The calculation is based on the number of trades placed per instrument.
